 used to the music through practice. Make a routine with productive practice. Without
 practicing, no improvement!
- **Recitals:** Once a year (May)
- **Music Theory:** For beginners, I give some theory assignments.

Recommendations for Parents:

Please encourage and remind your child/children to practice regularly. Also, expose your child/children to music recitals and concerts of any genre as he/she can be touched and inspired by music.
